- Key Insights from Surveys and Interviews:

Summarise the most relevant findings from surveys and interviews conducted in WP2. Focus on risks or concerns raised by professionals in your country.

- Recommendations and Context-Specific Solutions:

Propose strategies or recommendations that address identified risks, tailored to the national context. Highlight good practices or opportunities for improvement in your region. This work will inform the next task in WP4 (Task 2 – Defining Best Practices).
